Honorable guests, fellow citizens, and members of the press,

It is my distinct privilege to introduce the Honorable Patricia Williams, Secretary of Environmental Protection, who will address us on the state's new climate initiative.

Secretary Williams brings thirty years of public service to her role, having previously served as Deputy Director of the EPA and as an environmental attorney specializing in water rights legislation. She holds a Juris Doctor from Georgetown University and a Master's in Environmental Science from Yale.

Under her leadership, our state has implemented the most comprehensive renewable energy program in the nation, resulting in a 35% reduction in carbon emissions over the past four years. Her office has also secured \$2.8 billion in federal funding for green infrastructure projects.

Secretary Williams has been recognized by the National Environmental Association and received the Clean Air Award for her outstanding contribution to environmental policy.
